Title/Subject: Online Harms Intervention Delivery
Serial No: MPCC309
Summary: The VRP have undertaken research to refine our understanding of what young people's experiences of being online are in West Yorkshire, what impact this has on their mental health, and what opportunities for education-based interventions there may be to prevent, reduce and mitigate harm. Following on from this portfolio of research, our latest research report noted that the VRP has positioned itself as a future leader in this field and now has a real opportunity to pilot new approaches which could be scaled nationally and beyond. As such, we are now seeking to undertake an Expression of Interest Process to identify a provider(s) to deliver an effective online harms intervention in West Yorkshire, that adheres to the learning and principles raised within in our research.
Requested Decision: Approve the proposal for the West Yorkshire Violence Reduction Partnership to undertake an Expression of Interest process to identify and commission a provider(s) to deliver online harms intervention within West Yorkshire. Decision: Approved Approve the proposal to amend the budget of the 'Social Media & Online Harms programme Evaluation' set out in MPCC279 from a single in year tender to a maximum value of £40,000 to a multi-year tender for £45,000, to reflect the proposed delivery timescales.
