## Funding Your Police Results

2,715 people responded to the survey, of which 2,668 stated that they or somebody in their household pays council tax in West Yorkshire ( $98 \%$ ). The results below are based on the sample of council tax payers and answered each question; $78.6 \%$ of these respondents stated that they would be willing to pay more on their council tax.
