RESPONSE TO THE POLICE AND CRIME PANEL

Thank you for the report of the West Yorkshire Police and Crime Panel regarding the precept for 2018-19. We had a very useful discussion at the Panel meeting on the 2nd of February 2018 and I felt that there was a good level of understanding of the budgetary pressures facing the police and why I felt it necessary to propose a 7.9% precept increase. I will provide the requested information over the course of 2018/19 in line with the work programme for the Police and Crime Panel to give assurance that the commitments are being met.

In the light of the Panel's support for the proposed precept I confirm my approval of the Band D precept of £162.95 which is a 7.9% increase giving a precept figure of £104,814,929.
