Whilst this will enable the release of funding for subsequent detailed design of this section during 2015, a more comprehensive assessment of this enabling component will ultimately be required that appraises the wider strategy for the A629 Southern Section as a whole. CMBC now requires Consultant support to develop an evidence backed understanding of the highway efficiency issues along the adjacent section of the A629 corridor to the south (Phase 1b, fig 1), stretching from Jubilee Road to the Elland Bypass. This includes the Calder & Hebble intersection which is a well-known congestion hotspot. The principal aim is to overcome the issues identified by developing a preferred highway efficiency solution which formalises the strategy for the corridor and complements Phase 1a to the north.
